

## CCDW COMPARISON OF REVISIONS

BEFORE	AFTER
<p>Two types of instructors.</p> <p><b>1) Instructor Trainer</b> – taught by DOCJT. Certified to teach both instructors and applicants.</p> <p><b>2) Instructor</b> – taught by an Instructor Trainer. Certified to teach applicants.</p>	<p>Instructor Trainer classification eliminated and current Instructor Trainers will now be certified as Instructors only. All Justice Cabinet instructor training shall now be provided directly by DOCJT including recertification.</p>
No notification required.	All instructors must notify DOCJT 30 days in advance of each CCDW class. Must provide class time, date, place and roster.
No requirement on number of classes taught during the 3-year period to be qualified for recertification.	Instructors who do not teach a class in the 3 years they are certified will not be eligible for re-certification. May repeat the instructor course through DOCJT.
If an individual has violated instructor requirements <u>AND</u> becomes ineligible to hold a CCDW license, then the instructor certificate will be revoked.	If an individual has violated instructor requirements <u>OR</u> becomes ineligible to hold a CCDW license, then the instructor certificate will be revoked.

### Additional CCDW Information:

- The Instructor Trainer course was first taught in 1996, and 141 people were certified at that time. In 1999, the first renewal, 77 Instructor Trainers renewed their certification.
- As of February of 2002, there are 753 instructors in Kentucky.
- As of December 31, 2001, there were 71,770 CCDW license holders in Kentucky.
